WHILE ESTIMATES VARY, FIGURES SHOW UP TO **55,000** PEOPLE DIE FROM RABIES EACH YEAR. VACCINATING **70 PER CENT** OF AN AREA'S DOG POPULATION CAN PREVENT RABIES FROM SPREADING.
