More Helpful Equipment!

The ends of newsprint roles or newspaper, placed on top of a recovery blanket, prevents animals from laying on the same blanket as others before them.

These newspaper ends are otherwise thrown out.

Also seen right, a heating blanket under a recovery blanket and plastic tarp, put on a low setting provides warmth.

Pressure canners with a pressure gauge on top maintain pressure and heat at autoclave levels. A timer (seen here) ensures they are in for the correct amount of time after the unit has gotten to the correct pressure.

Sterilization pouches (seen right) have heat sensitive markers inside and outside of the pouch to ensure safety. The 7" X 13" pouches cost under 12 cents each and the pouch creates a sterile surface for the instruments once the pouch is opened.

A table-top anesthesia machine sits comfortably and safely behind the seat of a pick up truck.

With 36 folding cages and two lightweight surgery tables, a scale, donated dog food and supplies, a M*A*S*H program can travel nicely in a 3/4 ton truck.
